Purpose	This policy on students' work on courses delivered to all students at AAU. The purpose of the policy is to clarify the university's expectations with regard to students' work on courses delivered		
Scope	All courses delivered at AAU.		
Statement	Students are expected to submit their work in their course language. This includes assignments, homework, classwork, reports, projects, case studies, and so on. Students are not allowed to submit or present any work in a language other than the one the course is taught in. Failure to adhere to this requirement will result in a grade of zero (0) for that submission. All student work is subject to Turnitin plagiarism detection. A similarity percentage of up to 20% is allowed for undergraduate submissions, and a percentage of up to 15% is allowed for master's level submissions.		
Procedures	This policy applies to all undergraduate and postgraduate students, regardless of the college they are enrolled in. Cases will be considered based on the course, not the student's college affiliation. All violations will be clearly explained to the student. Administrative Procedures: A student accused of violating this policy, whether by a professor, a teaching assistant/graduate student, or a lab supervisor, has the right to resubmit the course work by the specified deadline to maintain compliance. Otherwise, the assigned grade will be zero (0).
